



The Dorset Theatre Festival is seeking an Artistic Associate Intern for their 2017 40th Anniversary Season. The candidate for this position will work directly under Artistic Director Dina Janis, assisting her in overseeing the Festival's renowned New Play Development Program as well as preparing all dramaturgical material for the planned season. The position, which would run from June 1st through September 4th, would involve acting as New Play Coordinator for three New Play Reading retreats with acclaimed national playwrights, leading and coordinating the public performances that are a finishing component of these retreats. The position also involves acting as dramaturg for each of the 4 Main Stage Productions and being responsible for the creation of the Program Notes for each show. Play Talk Backs would also be handled by this candidate.

Candidates for this position should have extremely strong writing skills, be comfortable in a public role doing talk-backs, have strong organizational ability and attention to detail. A valid driver's license is preferred. Playwrights, dramaturgs and directors are encouraged to apply.
