### **About Dorset Theatre Festival:**

From June to September, Dorset Theatre Festival mounts 4 main stage productions, in a charming 300-seat proscenium theatre built from 3 restored pre-revolutionary barns.

Every summer, Dorset Theatre Festival draws from some of this country's most talented playwrights, actors, and directors to launch new plays that go on to national acclaim, mount regional premieres to bring the best of Off-Broadway to Vermont, and incubate emerging playwrights and artists.

Dorset Theatre Festival's mission is to create bold, innovative, and authentic theatre that engages a diverse, multi-generational community, and economically diverse region: enlightening, entertaining, and inspiring our audience through the celebration of great plays. Locally engaged and nationally relevant, we produce theatre that matters.

### **About the Position:**

Dorset Theatre Festival, an acclaimed AEA summer company in Vermont, seeks a Sound Supervisor for its 2019 summer season. Employment dates run May 28 through early September.

Working in collaboration with the Production Manager and Production Designers, the Sound Supervisor will be responsible for audio operations, including all aspects of the implementation of sound designs for the Main Stage season of 4 plays and the Pipeline Series of staged readings, running show calls, and shared supervision of the Lighting/Sound Apprentice. The Sound Supervisor may also work electric calls including hangs, focus calls, and strikes. The Sound Supervisor and Master Electrician will alternate as board operators, with the Lighting/Sound Apprentice as a full-time board operator.

Minimum of 2 years professional sound supervision, engineering, or crew experience. The ideal candidate will have strong collaboration, communication and technical skills and be able to maintain high quality standards and a safe and supportive work environment while working on a tight timeline, and also have some experience as a teacher/mentor. A valid driver's license is required; access to personal vehicle desirable.

### **Compensation:**

Salary commensurate with experience, less a \$50 weekly housing contribution; single occupancy bedroom in a shared house for the summer season.
